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BOAT OF THE MONTH — VINTAGE

1969 Notre Dame (8th place in 2009)

Notes about the Real Boat: .Notre Dame, the eighth, was the product of Karelsen Custom Boats of Seattle. The Karelsen Notre Dame was arguably the fastest boat that had ever been built up to that time.





BOAT OF THE MONTH — MODERN

1974 Miss Cott's Beverage (11th place in 2009)

Notes about the Real Boat: Higgins campaigned the U-76 at all 11 races in 1974. The U-76 raced under several names in 1974. Early in the season it was the Miss Cott Bevrages. It was renamed the Miss Northwest Tank Service for the Gold Cup in Seattle. The last five races it ran as the Miss Technicolor.

JAMMY HANDRICKS TAKES ANOTHER SWING AT PREDICTIONS

Entering its eighth year, ERCU is maintaining its membership count at 54 with 112

boats registered.

Master prognosticator Jammy Handricks reports on his first effort on preseason predictions by noting that he should just have to do the top five in each category, as he correctly placed five of the top six boats in both vintage and modern classes. Gary Simmons' Miss Everett sneaked into sixth place in vintage, supplanting the Muvalong and Gary Hansen, which was hampered by rumored house-building at Lake Tapps, falling to lucky 13th place.

Hansen was hampered in the modern class as well, with the highly-regarded Miss Cott's Beverage affected only by attendance, falling to 11th place. Stepping into that vacated shoe was the U-95 of **Rick Lentz**, who sneaked into fourth place overall, with some help from alternate driver Gerry Borden, who shed his modern class trailer start limitation by running the U-95 at several events.

After the top six though, the shotgun approach to predicting totally failed.

In vintage, no correctly predicted finishes were made, even though some of the right boats were named.

The correct top 10 boats (prediction in parentheses) were 1. 1963 Notre Dame (3), 2. 1969 Pay N Pak (1), 3. 1957 Hawaii Kai (2), 4. Parco's O-Ring Miss (5), 5. 1971 Hallmark Homes (6). Totally missing the mark, Jammy didn't figure on 1960 Miss Everett (6), 1967 Atlas Van Lines (7), 1969 Notre Dame (8), Gale V (9) or Gale's Roostertail (10) finding their way into the top tier.

In modern, it wasn't too much of a gamble to pick a Mike Campbell boat as number one. But true to Jammy's luck (?) even that

turned out to be too difficult.

Even though he was somehow able to come up with seven of the top 10 boats, only one fell into the right slot. 1. 1974 Country Boy (4), 2. 1982 Executone (1), 3. 1978 Miss Circus Circus (2), 4. 1974 U-95 (9), 6. 1977 Charlie's Girl (6 - finally – one right!) and 9. 2009 Formula Boats (7) all managed to hit the top 10.

Missing it "by that much" was 7. 1976 Spirit of Dayton-Walther, 8. 1991 American Spirit and 10. 1994 Miss Budweiser.

Because the editor is feeling gracious (and probably because there are no other volun-





teers), Jammy will get another year to see if any valuable lessons have been learned. The usual culprits that hamper correct prognostication still include the economy, as well as life's little interferences.

At least those will be some of the excuses Jammy uses if this year's projections are as lame as last year's. With a strong inhale, here is what Jammy says will happen in 2010.

Those of you who are named, beware of the Jammy curse, and those who are slighted, cheer up, as your chances of moving into the coveted top 10 will be greatly improved.

One addition this year will be the selection of "the next four in", to honor March Madness Bracketology, another way of hedging bets when there are too many good boats to be able to select just 10 with any confidence.

These boats have shown the ability to knock out most of the top boats, depending on some luck and a decision on how much to run.

The next four in could be 1977 Natural Lite, 1974 Miss Cott's Beverages, 1994 Miss Budweiser and 1978 Squire Shop, all fast boats that will depend on that elusive luck and opportunity. In addition, there is the perennial question of which of "Mike's" boats can prevail.

This year "Mike" will have four chances to lead the pack, with the Circus hoping that indecision of which will be the points boat between Country Boy, Executone or Oberto

will open the top spot.

As usual, attendance and perseverance are keys to scoring points, and attending as many races a possible is a great way to build up the point totals. For that reason, boats with a little history of hitting a lot of races have an advantage in the selection process.

Of course, Jammy's best excuse for missing the mark will be "I didn't know it would attend/skip so many races this year". Such is the life of one who finds a limb to go out on. By the end of the year, there may be a plea to start clapping to save Jammy . . . Let the racing begin - go fast, turn left, and don't hit the dead boats - or (with three races in cement ponds this year) the concrete walls.
